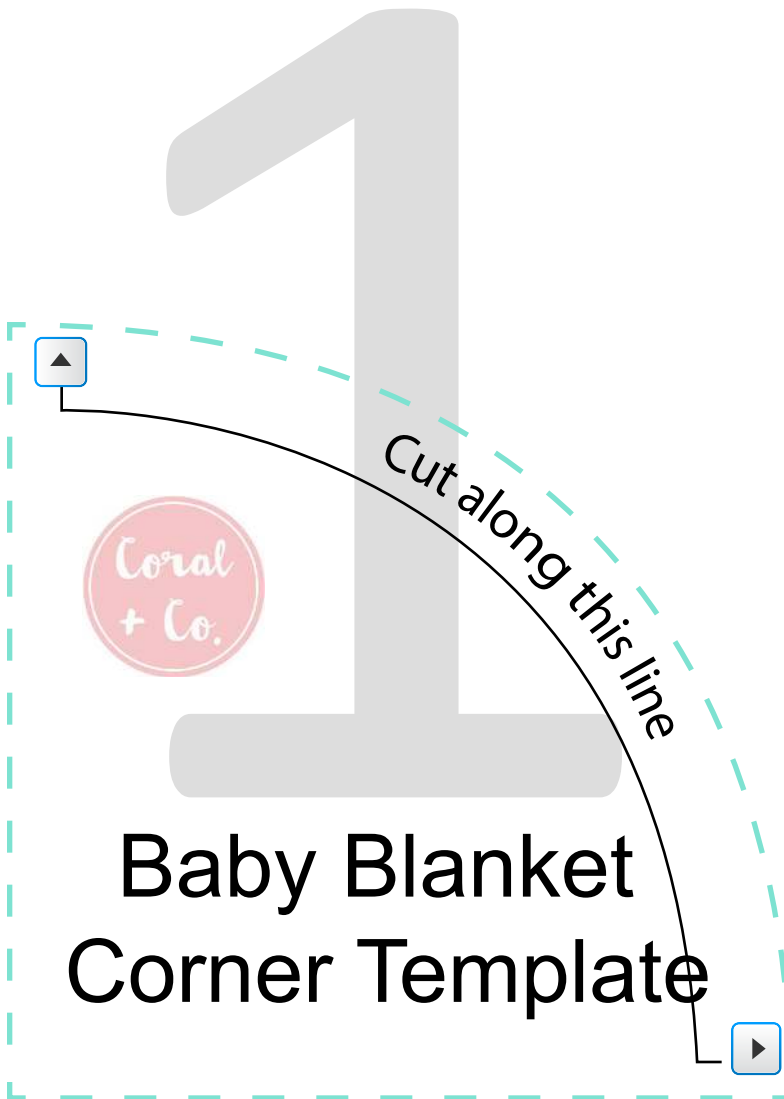

# 10 minute Baby Blanket Tutorial

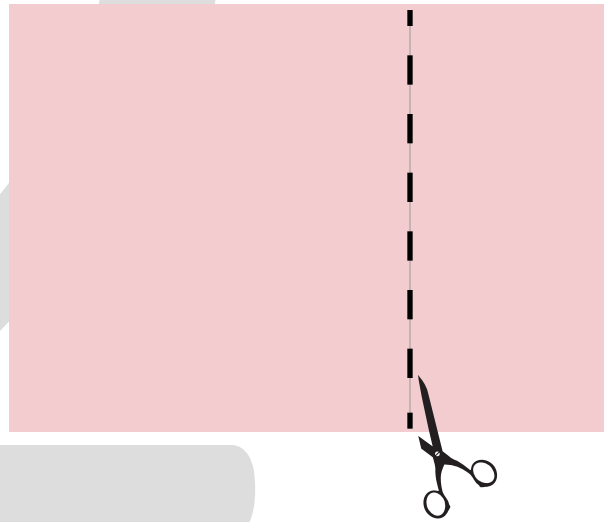
*Coral + co.*

Blanket finished  
dimensions: 36" x 36".

Recommended fabrics:  
Interlock Knit, Jersey  
Knit, or Flannel.

Need 1 Yard Fabric.

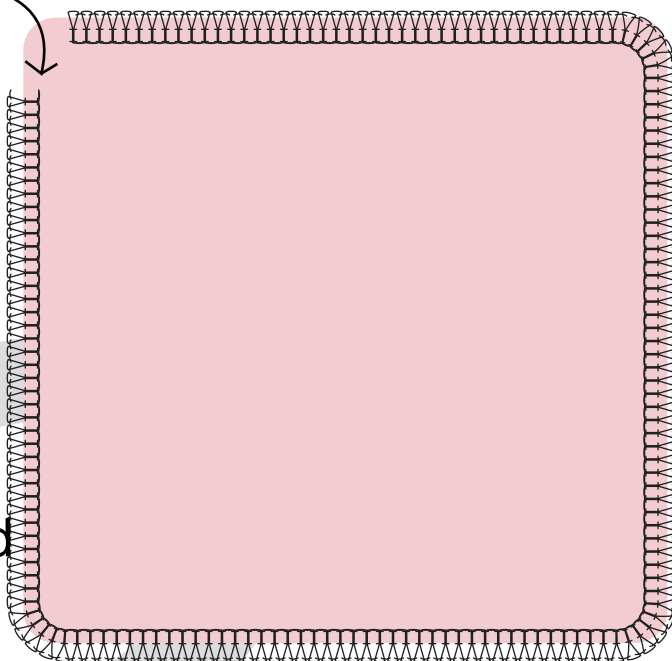
Using a rotary blade  
cut the long side of  
fabric to make a  
square 36" x 36".



Fold square in half,  
place corner  
template  
on both corners and  
cut off the square  
edges to make a  
square with  
rounded corners.

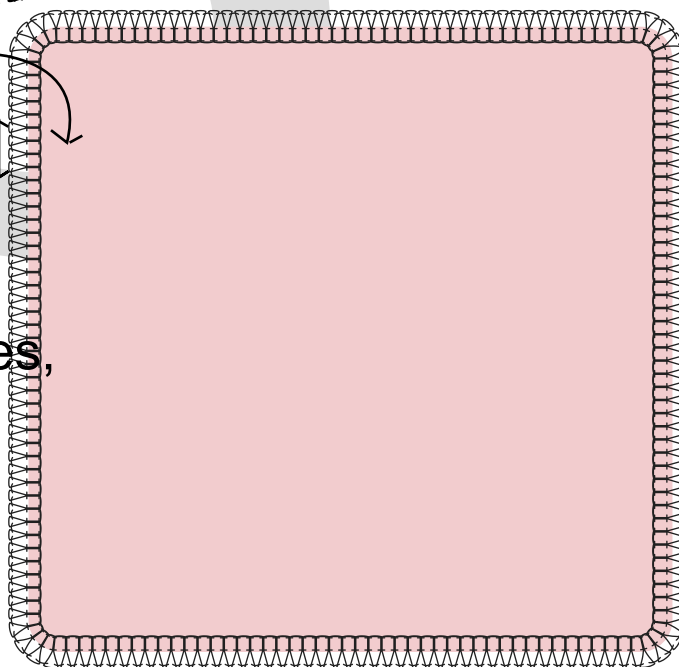
Using a serger or a zig zag stitch on a regular sewing sew around the perimeter of the blanket starting as the edge straightens right after the rounded corner.

*start here*



On Serger: Sew past the starting place, overlapping 1/2" - 1". Pull threads on needles, to slightly loosen, lift presser foot, and then flip blanket over sew back 1/2" to 1".

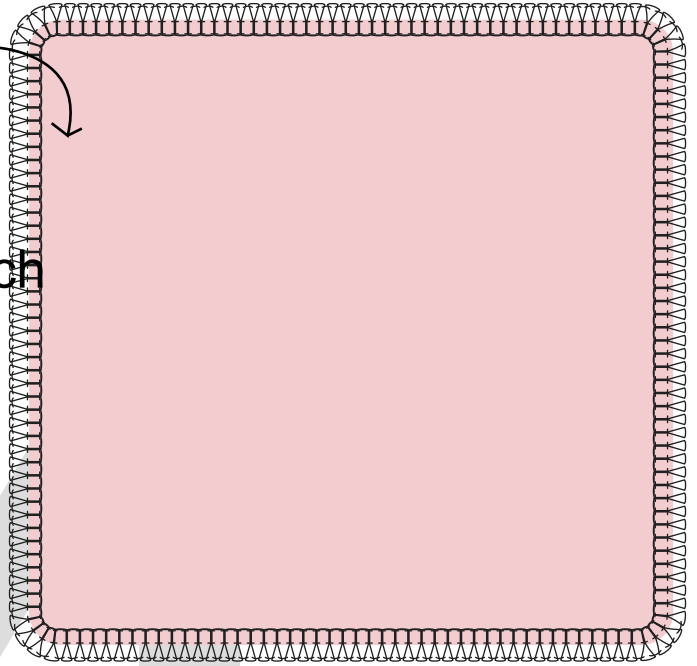
*overlap by 1"*

*Backstitch and secure.*

Sewing Machine:

starting point, backstitch  
and secure using a  
straight stitch.
